

# Take the bus!

The closest bus stops to St Columba's Church are:-

St Mark's Church, Convent Court, Raleigh Avenue and Clarendon Road.

On a Sunday the No 4 bus leaves Liberation Station at 10.15am and stops at St Mark's Church at 10.23am (it's a 1 minute walk from St Mark's to St Columba's)

The No 19 bus stops at Raleigh Avenue and Clarendon Road at 12.42pm and gets back to Liberation Station at 13.06pm

Monday to Saturday the No 24 Town Link bus stops at St Mark's Church every hour (usually 8 minutes past the hour)

Currently it costs £3 per journey (£1.50 for child) if paying with cash and £2.55 (£1.27 for child) if paying by card or pre-purchased ticket.

**If you are unable to reach your destination via one bus, then you can purchase a transfer ticket which will cover your additional second bus at no extra cost.** The ticket is only valid for 1 hour from time of purchase. Show the transfer ticket to the driver on your next bus. Please note that a transfer ticket cannot be used as a return ticket or a hop on, hop off service. An example would be that a transfer ticket can be used to catch Route 1 from Gorey to Liberation Station and then, using the same ticket, catch a 12a service from Liberation Station to Corbiere. An example where a transfer ticket cannot be used, is catching a Route 15 from the Airport, alighting in St Aubins momentarily, then boarding a 12a into town.
